Mr. Yamada – this is a good start for a first paragraph. Please let me give you some
advice that you can use to improve it for the next time. First of all, let's start with the
format. Please turn off the grid, before you begin writing (see first comment). Usually
academic writing is properly double spaced, and the beginning of the paragraph is
indented by pressing the TAB key once. The paragraph is also set to the left and is not
justified. Next, let's look at the content. The first sentence is called the topic sentence,
and it tells the reader what the paragraph is about. All of the sentences in the
paragraph must connect to this one idea. Then normal paragraphs will have 3- 5 main
points followed by specific examples or reasons. Then comes the concluding sentence at
the end. It is similar in meaning to the topic sentence.
